CALIFORNIA HOUSE is a re-interpretation of the mid-century modern style of architecture that became so popular originally in the suburbs of California, and later in Adelaide. It is one of the few architectural styles that stands the test of time from that era.

This style is emphasised by glass walls, open floor plans that connect to the outdoors and the extensive overhung roof canopy that appears to float over the glazed walls.
